

## Instructions

1. Cast on 66 sts
2. Rows 1-6 Knit
3. Row 7 \* K2, P2 repeat from \* to end of row
4. Row 8 \*P2, K2 repeat from \* to end of row
5. Rows 9-18 Repeat Rows 7 & 8 5 more times
6. Rows 19-22 Knit to end (4 rows)
7. Rows 23-34 Repeat rows 7 & 8 (6 times)
8. Rows 35-38 Knit to end (4 rows)
9. Row 39 K2tog, knit to end of row (65 sts)
10. Row 40 Purl
11. Row 41 Knit
12. Row 42 Purl

## 13. Shape the top

- 1st Row \*K6, K2tog repeat from \* to end of row (57sts)
- 2nd, 4th, 6th, 8th 10th Rows: Purl
- 3rd Row \*K5, K2tog repeat from \* to end of row (49sts)
- 5th Row \*K4, K2tog repeat from \* to end of row (41sts)
- 7th Row \*K3, K2tog repeat from \* to end of row (33sts)
- 9th Row \*K2, K2tog repeat from \* to end of row (25sts)
- 11th Row \*K1, K2tog repeat from \* to end of row (17sts)
- 12th Row \*P2tog repeat from \* to last st, K1 (9sts)

14. Cut the yarn leaving a long tail to use to sew up the seam.

15. Draw the end of the yarn through all the stitches and gather together tightly.

16. Sew up the seam with the tail of yarn

## Abbreviations

st/s	stitch/es
K	Knit
P	Purl
K2tog	Knit 2 stitches together
P2tog	Purl 2 stitches together

### Notes

- The front, back and sleeves are knitted in one piece to the end of the yoke.
- The Jacket is commenced at the neck edge.

### Hints

- When you cast on leave an end of wool long enough to sew on the buttons.
- When you cast off each piece, leave a long end to sew up with.

## Knitting

1. Cast on 73 stitches.
2. 1st row: \* K1, P1, rep from \* to last st., K1.
3. Rep. 1st row 7 times, making a buttonhole thus, in the 3rd row —  
K1, P1, K1, wl fwd, K2 tog, continue P1, K1 to end of row.  
(Note: make 2nd buttonhole in the same way, 2" from the first.)
4. 9th row: K1, P1, across 7 stitches (moss st. ) then K2, (inc, once in next st, K1)
5. 28 times, K1, moss st last 7 stitches. (101 sts).  
(Keep 7 st moss st bands on left and right fronts throughout.)
6. Using No.10 needles work raglan shaping as follows —
7. 1st row: Moss st 7, K15, wl fwd, K1, wl fwd, K12, wl fwd, K1, wl fwd, K29, wl fwd, K1, wl fwd, K12, wl fwd, K1, wl fwd, K15, moss st 7.  
2nd and alt rows: Moss st 7, purl to last 7 sts, moss st 7.  
3rd row: Moss st 7, K16, wl fwd, K1, wl fwd, K14, wl fwd, K1, wl fwd, K31, wl fwd, K1, wl fwd, K14, wl fwd, K1, wl fwd, K16, moss st 7.
8. Continue in this manner, increasing as before in every alt. row, up to and including the following 2 rows.
9. First row: Moss st 7, K31, wl fwd, K1, wl fwd, K44, wl fwd, K1, wl fwd, K61, wl fwd, K1, wl fwd, K44, wl fwd, K1, wl fwd, K31, moss st 7.
10. Next row: Moss st 7, purl to last 7 stitches, moss st 7
11. Work left front as follows —  
1st row: Moss st. K33, turn.  
2nd row: Purl to last 7 stitches, moss st 7.
12. Continue in stocking stitch, with moss st band, at the same time inc. once at side edge in next and every following 4th row until there are 37 sts. plus 7 moss st.
13. Work 17 rows without shaping.
14. Proceed as follows —  
1st row: \*K1,P1, rep from \* to end of row.  
2nd row: \*P1, K1, rep from \* to end of row.  
3rd row: as 1st row.  
4th row: as 2nd row.  
5th row: Moss st 7, Knit to end of row

## MATINEE JACKET contd.

- 6th row: Purl to last 7 sts, moss st 7
- 7th row: as 5th row.
- 8th row: (P3, K7,) until last 14 sts, P3, K4, moss st 7.
- 9th row: As 5th row.
- 10th row: As 6th row.
- 11th row: As 5th row.
- 12th row: P1, K1, repeat to end of row.
- 13th row: K1, P1, repeat to end of row.
- 14th row: As 12th row. Cast off loosely in moss st.
- 15.** Re-join wool to remaining stitches and work sleeve as follows —
- 1st row: K46, turn.
- 2nd row: purl.
- 16.** Continue in stocking stitch, dec. once at each end in 3rd and then every following 6th row, until 38 sts remain.
- 17.** Next row: \*P3, P2tog, rep. from \* to end of row. (31 sts).
- 18.** Cont on No.10 needles and proceed as follows —
- 1st row: K1, P1, rep. to end of row.
- 2nd row: K1, P1, rep. to end of row.
- 3rd row: As 1st row.
- 4th row: As 2nd row
- 5th row: Knit.
- 6th row: Purl.
- 7th row: Knit.
- 8th row: K4, (P3, K7) twice, P3, K4.
- 9th row: As 5th.
- 10th row: As 6th.
- 11th row: As 7th.
- 19.** Moss st for 3 rows then cast off loosely in moss st.
- 20.** Re-join wool to remaining stitches and work back as follows —
- 1st row: K65, turn.
- 2nd row: Purl.
- 21.** Continue in stocking stitch, inc. once at each end in next and every following 4th row, until there are 73 sts.
- 22.** Work 17 rows without shaping.
- 23.** Work 4 rows moss st and then 3 rows in stocking stitch as before.
- 24.** 8th row.: (P3, K7) to last 3 sts, P3.
- 25.** Work 3 rows stocking stitch then 3 rows moss st as before, then cast off loosely in moss st.
- 26.** Re-join wool to remaining stitches and work sleeve as follows —
- 1st row: K46 turn.
- 27.** Continue as for first sleeve.
- 28.** Re-join wool to remaining stitches and work right front as follows —
- 1st row: Knit to last 7 sts, K1, P1, to last st, K1.
- 2nd row: Moss st 7, Purl to end.
- 29.** Continue work to correspond to left front.

## Notes

- The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ).
- Sizes: 3 mos (6 mos-12 mos)

## Abbreviations

<b>K</b>	knit
<b>k2tog</b>	knit next 2 stitches together
<b>K2togtbl</b>	knit 2 stitches together through back loops
<b>P2tog</b>	purl two stitches together
<b>P2togtbl</b>	purl 2 stitches together through back loops
<b>Pssso</b>	pass slipped stitch over
<b>Sl1</b>	slip next stitch knitwise
<b>Sl1P</b>	slip next stitch purlwise
<b>Yf</b>	bring yarn into front of work
<b>Yfwd</b>	yarn forward (makes 1 extra stitch)

## Knitting

1. Cast on 27 (35-43) sts.
2. 1st and alt rows: (WS). Knit.
3. 2nd row: K1. yfwd. K12 (16-20). yfwd. K1. yfwd. K12 (16-20). yfwd. K1. 31 (39-47) sts.
4. 4th row: K1. yfwd. K14 (18-22). yfwd. K1. yfwd. K14 (18-22). yfwd. K1. 35 (43-51) sts.
5. 6th row: K1. yfwd. K16 (20-24). yfwd. K1. yfwd. K16 (20-24). yfwd. K1. 39 (47-55) sts.
6. Knit 11 rows (garter st).

## Shape Toe

7. 1st row: K15 (19-23). K2tog. K5. Sl1. K1. pssso. Sl1. yf. Turn.
8. 2nd row: K2tog. K5. Sl1. K1. pssso. yf. Sl1P. Turn.
9. 3rd row: K2tog. K5. Sl1. K1. pssso. Sl1. yf. Turn.
10. 4th row: As 2nd row.
11. 5th row: K2tog. K5. Sl1. K1. pssso. Sl1. Turn.
12. 6th row: P2togtbl. P5. P2tog. Sl1P. Turn.
13. 7th and 8th rows: As 5th and 6th rows once more.
14. 9th row: K2tog. K5. Sl1. K1. pssso. Knit to end of row. 21 (29-37) sts.
15. 10th row: Purl.
16. 11th row: K1. \*Yfwd. K2tog. Repeat from \* to end of row.
17. 12th row: Purl
18. Cont in garter st for 2 (2½-2½) ins [5 (6-6) cm], ending with a WS row. Cast off.

## Finishing

19. Sew sole seam. Sew back seam, reversing seam 1½ ins [4 cm] from cast off edge for turn back.

## Knitting

1. Cast on 10 stitches.
2. Knit 16 rows of plain knitting, break off wool and leave stitches on needle.
3. Cast on another 10 stitches, and knit 16 rows of plain knitting (this makes two legs).
4. Join to the other 10 stitches, and knit across 20 stitches.
5. Work 16 rows of stocking stitch.
6. With right side facing, cast on 10 stitches, then knit across all 30 stitches.
7. Cast on 10 stitches, knit across these 10 stitches, then purl 20, knit 10.
8. Continue in this way for 10 rows, keeping arms plain, but body in stocking stitch.
9. Next row, cast off 10 stitches, knit 30 stitches.
10. Next row, cast off 10 stitches, purl 20 stitches.
11. Continue in stocking stitch for 32 rows.
12. With right side facing, cast on 10 stitches to make arm, then knit across the 30 stitches.
13. Next row, cast on 10 stitches, knit across these 10, purl 20, knit 10.
14. Continue in this way for 10 rows, keeping arms plain and body in stocking stitch.
15. Next row, cast off 10 stitches, knit 30
16. Next row, cast off 10 stitches, purl 20.
17. Work 16 rows of stocking stitch.
18. Knit 16 rows of plain on 10 stitches.
19. Cast off.
20. Rejoin wool to remaining 10 stitches, knit 16 rows plain.
21. Cast off.

## To make up

1. Fold knitting in half, right sides together.
2. Join all around with backstitch, leaving opening in side to stuff.
3. Turn to right side out, fill with nylon stuffing – not too fat – then stitch up side opening.
4. Run a gathering thread around neck, and draw in and tie off.
5. Embroider face.
6. Stitch across corners of head to form small ears.
7. Fasten a bow at neck.

## Pattern Variations

- For the front of the teddy – after 2nd lot of arms have been completed, moss stitch the middle 16 stitches.
- Continue for 24 rows.
- Revert back to pattern for legs.
- Basket stitch could also be used in place of moss stitch.
